PROSPECTUS FOR 2019-2020

1. COLLEGE SESSION:

The college will re-open on Saturday, the 15th June, 2019 at 11.00 a.m.

2. ADMISSION:

- (i) A candidate has to submit the application form duly signed by his parent / guardian. The candidate should fill up the form in his / her handwriting only. Prospectus obtainable from the college office on payment of Rs. 100/ only.
- (ii) Every student willing to join the college for the session 2019-20 will have to join some <u>Unit of National Cadet Corps</u> or N. S. S. conducted by the College. No exemption will be allowed.
- (iii) Application form should be accompanied by -
- (a) Rs. 30/- Registration (Non refundable).
- (b) Certified copy of Leaving Certificate from the school or Transfer and Attendance Certificate from the college last attended.
- (c) As per the ordinance No.2 of R.T.M. Nagpur University Nagpur for admission to a college, the student shall produce the original school leaving College Leaving certificate, as the case may be, signed by the Head of the Institution/College last attended.
- (d) A photo copy of statement of marks obtained by the candidate in the last examination passed by him/her duly certified by a gazetted officer or the Head of a recognised institution.
- (e) Character Certificate from the Head master / principal of the school / college last attended.
- (f) Caste Certificate (for students belonging to S.C., S.T., N.T./V.J., O.B.C. and special backward class categories)
- (g) Court affidavit stating that the student did not join any other institution after passing last University/ Board Examination. This affidavit is necessary only if there is a gap of one or more years between passing the last Examination and Joining the college.
- (h) Migration Certificate in the case of students who have passed their last qualifying examination of a University or a Board other than Nagpur university or Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education & Eligibility Certificate from Nagpur University.
- (i) Income Certificate from Gazetted Officer of State Government for students who wish to claim freeship / scholarship.

The originals of these documents must be produced at the time of admission. The original School/College Leaving Certificate will be retained by the College for its permanent record and will not be returned in any case. The original mark list will however be returned after verification immediately at the time of admission. Please do not submit original marklist.

The reservation of seats for backward class & physically handicapped students will be made as per the University directives.

If the factual information has been suppressed in the application form and it comes to the notice of the college after admission at any time, he/she will be liable to expulsion besides other action as may be deemed fit.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

A) B.Sc. Semester I, II

For admission to Semester I and II the student should have passed Higher Secondary (Class XII) Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or an Examination recognised by Nagpur University as equivalent thereto.

(B) B.Sc. Semester III, IV

For admission to Semester III and IV the student should have passed Semester I and II examination of RTM Nagpur University or an examination recognized by it as equivalent thereto as per ATKT rule.

(C) B.Sc. Semester V, VI

For admission to Semester V and VI the student must have cleared all subjects of Semester I and II Examination of RTM Nagpur University or an examination recognized by it as equivalent thereto. ATKT rules are applied for Semester III and IV.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA for M.Sc.

5. MODE OF ADMISSION:

(I) List of students provisionally selected for admission will be put on the College Notice Board from time to time after the expiry of last date for submission of application form for admission, such students will produce the original of School / College Leaving Certificate and Marklist of the last examination passed and also pay requisite fees before the prescribed date. In case of failure to do so the applicants will loose their claim for admission. In no case the students will be informed about their admission to college by post. The applicants are therefore, advised to see the Notice Board everyday. No admission is allowed on Duplicate college leaving certificate (As a special case if admitted on Duplicate college leaving certificate such students will have to pay full fees.)

- (ii) Every student who is admitted to the College is responsible for payment of Tuition fees and other fees for the whole session irrespective of the date of his/her admission or upto and inclusive of the month of Leaving the College, as the case may be.

The students desiring to leave the College in the middle of the session must intimate the Principal accordingly in writing, otherwise the Tuition fees will continue to be charged till the end of the session or the month of giving the intimation whichever is earlier.

8. REFUND OF DEPOSITS :-

Caution money and library deposits of the students will not be refunded as long as their names are on the College rules. He/She should submit an application for refund to the Principal after getting it countersigned by his/her parents or guardian. All such applications will be considered after 1st August. The amount to be refunded will be decided at after deducting all uncleared dues.

Caution money and Library deposit due for refund but not claimed within three years will not be refunded.

9. FEES FOR COLLEGE LEAVING AND OTHER CERTIFICATES:-

No fees will be charged for a College Leaving Certificate, if asked by the student within a year from the date of leaving the college or from the date of the result of the University Examination for which the student appeared from the college. After this period a fees of Rs. 100/- will be charged for every subsequent year subject to a maximum of Rs. 500/-

Attested copies of the certificate submitted by the student at the time of admission will be issued on payment of Rs. 5/- for each certificate submitted.

Issue of Duplicate College Leaving Certificate

The student requiring a duplicate copy of the College Leaving Certificate should state in writing as to what happened to the original certificate and why a duplicate is required. He will have to make an affidavit before a stipendiary Magistrate in case the reasons given by the student are not found satisfactory. The student will have to pay fees of ₹ 100 /- only for duplicate copy. There is no provision of issue of College Leaving Certificate for third time.

10. ATTENDANCE:-

- a) In order to qualify as candidate for University examinations every student as a rule must attend not less than 75% of the lectures and practicals delivered in every month in each of their subject of study. Students enrolled in N.C.C. or P.T. classes must put in 80% attendance and attend camp (s), if any. It will entirely be the responsibility of the students to keep up regular attendance. If the attendance is short the name of each defaulter will be removed from the rolls.
- b) Fine of Rs. 10/- per day will be imposed on a student who remains absent from the college without leave.
- c) Applications submitted for the purpose of leave should be countersigned by the parent or guardian. Medical leave applications should be accompanied by medical certificate.
- d) Leave or absence will be entirely at the student's own risk and a certificate of any kind will not condone a deficiency in attendance (classes and N.C.C.) required by the university.
- e) The students getting scholarship or freeship are further warned that their scholarships or freeships will entirely depend on their regular attendance & satisfactory progress in studies, if a student belonging to aforesaid categories fails to put in 75 percent attendance he/she will have to pay full fees irrespective of the ground of absence.
- f) Absence without leave from a college examination will entail a fine of ₹ 10/-per paper subject to maximum of Rs. 50/- for one examination.
- g) All applications for leave must be submitted within seven days from the last day of the leave period. Applications received later than this will not be considered at all.

11. IDENTITY CARD :-

Fresh Identity Card shall be issued for each academic year. Student should always carry Identity card whenever they are in campus. If any student is found in college premises without Identity Card he is liable for being fined suitably.

Those students, who have lost their Identity Card will be issued fresh Identity Card on payment of ₹ 50/- only.

12. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:-

Every student on the roll of the College according to the University rules, must present himself for medical inspection before the Medical Officer appointed by the College on such date as may be fixed by the Medical Officer in consultation with Principal. The Medical inspection of the students will be held in the premises of the College once in each academic year.

A student who remains absent from Medical Examination at the appointed date and time without any sufficient cause shall be liable to pay to the College an extra medical examination fees of ₹ 100/- or such smaller amount as the Principal may fix before he is examined.

If a student fails to present himself for medical inspection without sufficient cause even after repeated opportunities, he will have to pay fine of Rs. 100/- only.

13. PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND RECREATION OF STUDENTS:-

- (a) Under Ordinance No. 3 of the Nagpur University all the under Graduate students of the College can join NCC required to participate in any of the following activities:-
 - 1. National Cadet Corps (Open Unit) 2. Physical Training

All students who opt for physical Training shall attend the physical training period thrice a week in the prescribed uniform. They shall attend a minimum of 60 periods in a session. The classes will be held from 2018 to 2019.

All the Students admitted to college shall present themselves for Physical Efficiency Test before the Committee of Examiners on such dates and at such time as may be fixed by the Principal. Those who have joined N.C.C. may present themselves for Physical Efficiency Test if they so desire.

If a student fails to present himself for physical efficiency test without sufficient cause, he will be fined $\ref{thm:physical}$ 100/-

(b) Ordinance No. 2 of 1996 provided Ten (10) Credit Marks as an incentive to the students participating in National Service Scheme (NSS), Adult Continuing Education & Extension Service (ACEES), National Cadet Corps (NCC) (Open Unit), Games & Sports and Cultural Activities.

14. FACILITIES FOR STUDENTS :-

(A) LIBRARY

Our library is fully computerised with very precious collection of 33596 books on various subject. We have huge collection of periodical, digital material, magazines and other reference books. We subscribe number of reputed journals, magazine, newsletters and mewspapers. Our Library provide free internet, **INFLIBNET N-List, OPAC, e-Literacy** Programme. Internet use learning and also free online diploma courses from world's best universities. We also conduct various programmes and competitions regarding reading habit development.

(B) READING ROOM

The College has made provision for a separate Reading Room.

(C) COLLEGE MAGAZINE

The annual magazine 'Prerana' which contains the articles written by students in Marathi, Hindi and English is published. They can approach Dr. J. A. Janbandhu and other language teachers for publishing.

(D) CYCLE STAND

Provision has been made for cycle stand for the use of students. Students bringing bicycles, scooters to the college shall keep them on the cycle stand & nowhere else and pay the necessary charges to the contractor. They should lock their vehicles. The contractor will not be responsible for loss of unlocked vehicles from cycle stand. No cognizance of any loss of vehicles will be taken if the vehicle is kept outside the Cycle Stand.

(F) CANTEEN

(G) COLLEGE EXAMINATION

The examinations, unit tests, terminal test exam of the college will be held on the dates fixed by the CDC. Every student must appear in all these examinations.

Absentees without prior permission will have to pay a fine of ₹ 50/- per paper. Students securing marks less than 35% will be provided remedial coaching and their names will be reported to their Parents/Guardians.

The following categories of students may get exemption as per the rules made by the CDS.

a) Students appearing at the winter examination of Nagpur University should produce an evidence to that effect before the commencement of the test Examination.

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- b) A Student claiming exemption on medical ground, requests exemption should produces a medical certificate from any one of the medical officers appointed by the college.
- Any other ground as per the discretion of the Principal that enables the student to claim exemption.

(H) INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

FREESHIP & FINANCIAL AID

The following freeships awarded by the Govt. are made available to students. The students awarded freeship under these Schemes must attend at least 75% of lectures and practicals as also 80% of N.C.C. Parades / P. T. Classes and must show satisfactory progress in their studies. Failure to do so will result in withdrawal of this concession. In such cases; students shall have to pay the full fees College .

- 1. Freeship to Economically Backward Class Student: The eligible students should apply to the Principal in the prescribed form within 30 days from the date of their admission to the College and obtain receipt from office.
- 2. Freeship to sons & daughters of Primary School Teachers: The eligible students should submit their application in the prescribed form in College Office within 30 days from the date of their admission to the College and obtain receipt.
- 3. Freeship is awarded to the S.C., S.T. (No Limit of annual income), N.T., V.J., SBC, OBC (8 lacs annual income)
- 4. Freeship to the children of Service Personnel.
- 5. Students Welfare Fund has been established by the University for giving financial assistance to the needy students by way of loan carrying simple interest at 8% P. A. The freeship will be awarded to eligible students on merit-cum-means basis. G.O.I. Scholarship holder should open S.B. account in the month of September in any bank.
- 6. No Concession available to students from outside the State of Maharashtra.

Important Rules for freeship under the E.B.C. Scheme (Income Below ₹ 8,00,000/-) Per annum

The Students applying for freeship under the E.B.C. Scheme of the State Government must submit their application in the prescribed form alongwith the Income Certificate from a Gazetted Officer of State Govt. not below the rank of Tahasildar, or class II officer of any department. President of Mpl. Committee, Sarpanch, etc. (for the students whose parent's ordinary place of residence is in rural area with a population below 10,000) to the College office within 30 days from the date of their admission to the college and otain receipt.

The students from outside the State of Maharashtra and the students whose father or guardian reside outside the State of Maharashtra are not entitled to this Freeship.

In case the E.B.C. applications are signed by mother when father is alive the circumstances in which the father could not sign the application alongwith the information on the following points should be submitted by the students & attached to his application. In case of legal separation of father and mother, an affidavit to this effect should be submitted and attached to his application.

- 1. Full name of the father.
- 2. Occupation and address.
- 3. Annual Income from all sources for previous year.

In case where the applications is signed by a person other than father / mother when alive, the procedure mentioned above should be followed.

In case the student seeks admission after lapse of year(s), a gap certificate to the effect that he did not join any educational institution prior to his admission in the institution should be submitted and attached to the application.

The student should take specific care that the income shown in the E.B.C. form is the same as shown by him / her / his in his application for admission.

SCHOLARSHIPS

(A) The following scholarships awarded by the State Govt. are made available to the students. The students awarded scholarship under this scheme must attend the college regularly. The scholarship will be withdrawn in case he fails to attend 75% of lectures, practicals and 80% of N.C.C. parades or P.T. classes every month and progress of the student is not satisfactory. In such cases, the students will have to pay full fees to College.

Various scholarships that can be availed students are

- 1. National Scholarship.
- 2. Scholarship to the children of primary & secondary school teacher.
- 3. Govt. of India Scholarships to backward class students.
- 4. Govt. Open Merit Scholarship.
- 5. Scholarship to the children of freedom fighters.
- 6. Talent Development Scholarship in Maths & Physics.
- (B) The College offers scholarships to a deserving students of each class of 1000 ₹ per students per class.

Important Information Regarding Government of India Post Matric Scholarship to the Backward Class Students

The scheme of grant of Government of India Scholarship to the backward class sudents, Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes, Nomadic Tribes / Vimukta Jatis and Scheduled Tribes outside specific area in Vidarbha and Nav-Buddhas formerly belonging to Scheduled Caste for post S. S. C. courses is implemented by the Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Pune. All the backward Class students and Nav-Buddhas formerly belonging to Scheduled Caste undertaking approved post S. S. C. Course are considered eligible for the Govt. of India Scholarships with the following exceptions.

- 1. The student switching over to non professional line after completing professional course in one viz. LL.B. after B.Ed., B.E. after LL.B. will not be held eligible.
- The students failing in the Term / Annual Examination are not considered eligible for the scholarships.
 One failure is however condoned in respect of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes students pursuing Medical and Engineering courses.
- 3. (i) The income limit is Rs.1,00,000/- annually for NT, OBC, SBC and for SC, ST students the income limit is ₹ 2,50,000/- annually.
 - (ii) The students whose guardians/family income is beyond above said limit should apply for only freeship within 15 days from date of admission.
 - (iii) Means Test will be made applicable to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes students.
 - (iv) Students who are in full time employment will not be eligible for scholarships.
 - v) Only two children of the same Parents / Guardians will be entitled to receive Scholarships.

FEES

The students who are eligible for Government of India Scholarship will not be required to pay fees which are of compulsory nature.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF FORM FOR G.O.I. SCHOLARSHIP

All backward class students and the students coming under the Lower Income Groups should apply for the Govt. of India Scholarship in the prescribed form through their respective College in the month of July only. The application forms will be made available to them at the time of admission. All the students should be vigilant enough to fill in the forms complete in all respect and any omission or incorrect / false information would to disqualify them from claiming the above Scholarship. The students having gap in their education should invariably file a appropriate affidavit.
