# 3.4.1. Extension activities are carried out in the neighborhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the years.

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, NSS Unit of the College under the guidance and support of President of Nagpur Shikshan Mandal Shri Ashokji Gandhi, Secretory Dr. Harishji Rathi, members of management, Principal of the College Dr. Jeevan R. Dontulwar Vice Principal and IQAC Coordinator Dr. R. S. Saha and NSS Coordinator Shri Prashant Nimje. All covid-19 safety norms like social distancing and safety precautions given by Govt. were followed.

### Activity 1 – Date: 06.06.2020: Distribution of face masks, medicine and food items:

Face masks, homeopathic medicine (immunity booster) *Arsenicum album-30* and nonperishable food material were distributed by NSS volunteers near the college. Around 150 needy, homeless and underprivileged members of the society around the college benefited from this. The food items were prepared and packed in the college under hygienic conditions. The teaching and non-teaching staff members were present.

The homeopathic medicine *Arsenicum album 30* was distributed in consultation with Dr. Rajesh Ratkantiwar, homeopathic practitioner at Sakkardara Square. Dr. Ratkantiwar explained the significance of this immunity booster medicine and dosage too.




