7.1.5. Green campus initiatives include - Evidences

1. Restricted entry of automobiles:

No unauthorized vehicles are allowed to enter the college premises. The main college building is quite away from the main entry gate. After the vehicle enters the main entry gate, separate parking slots are available for bicycles, scooters and cars.
