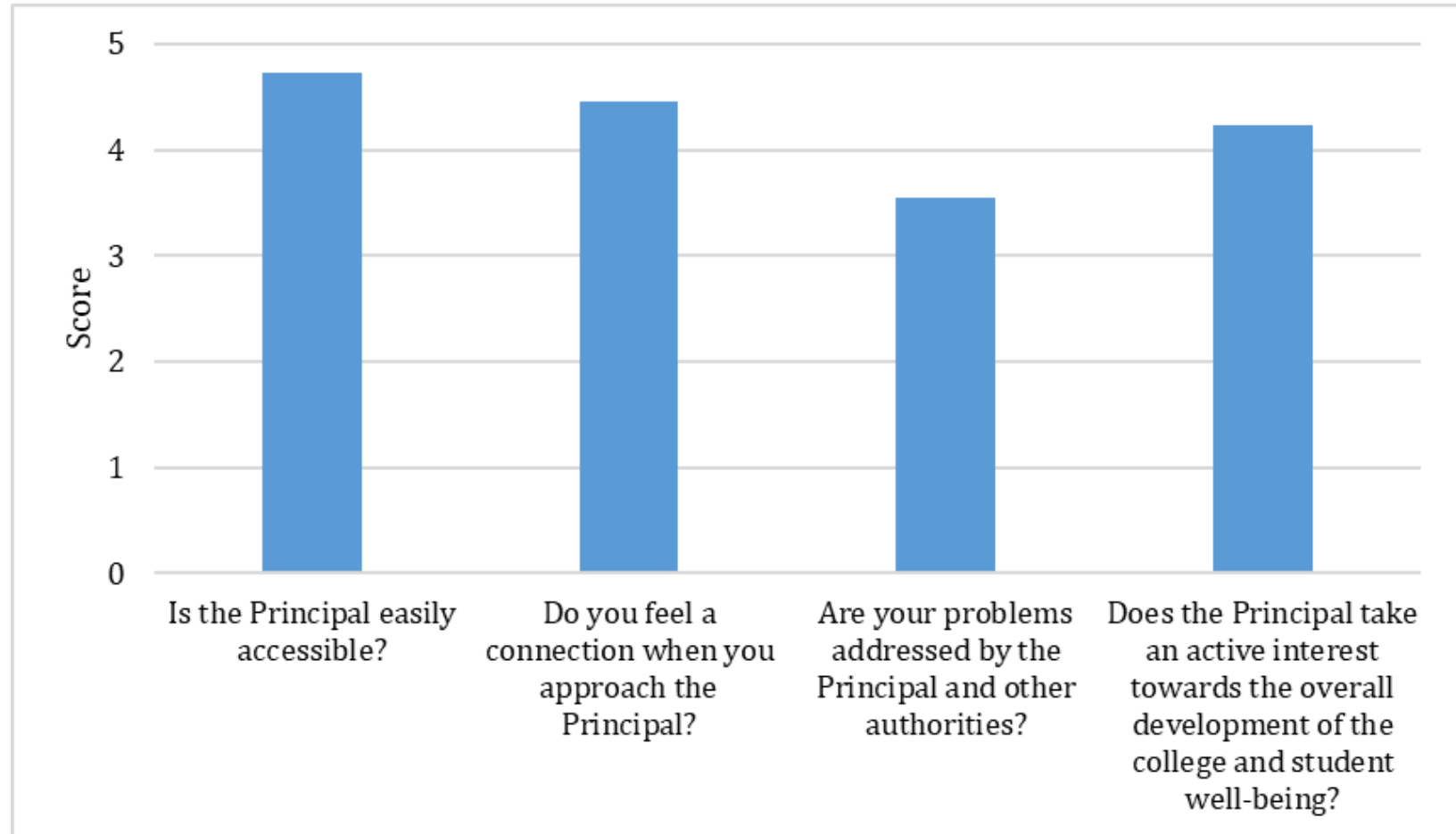

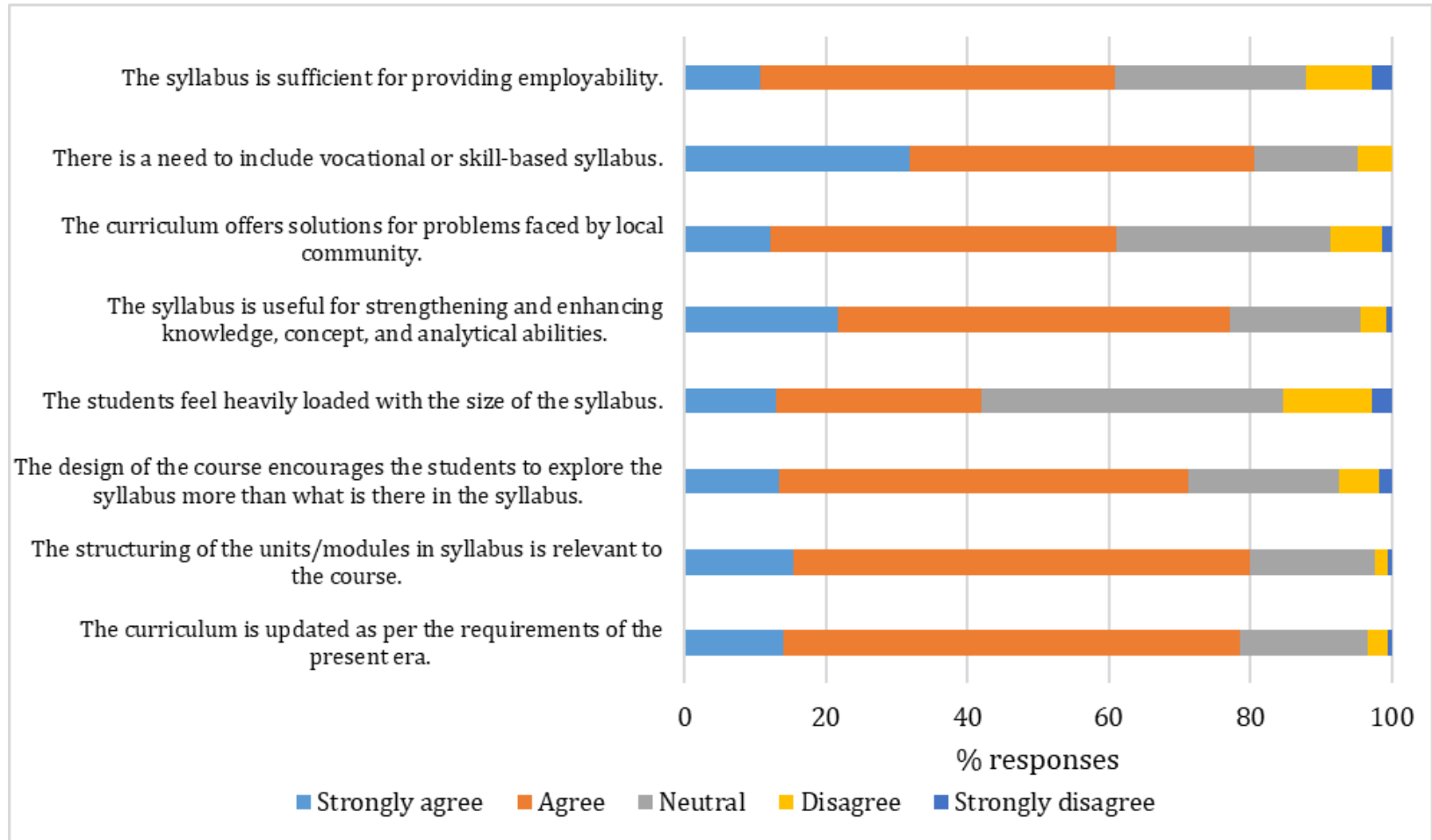

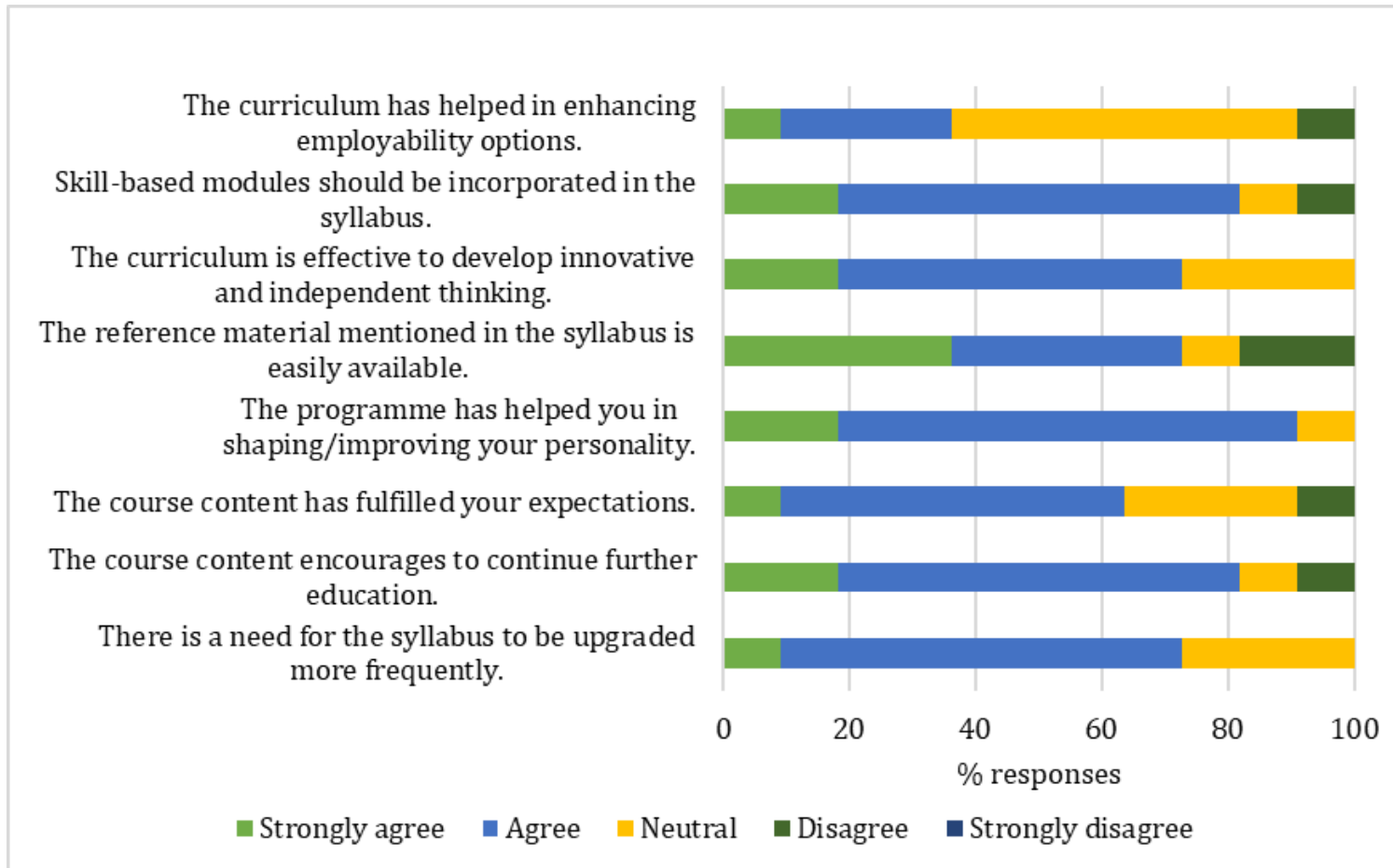

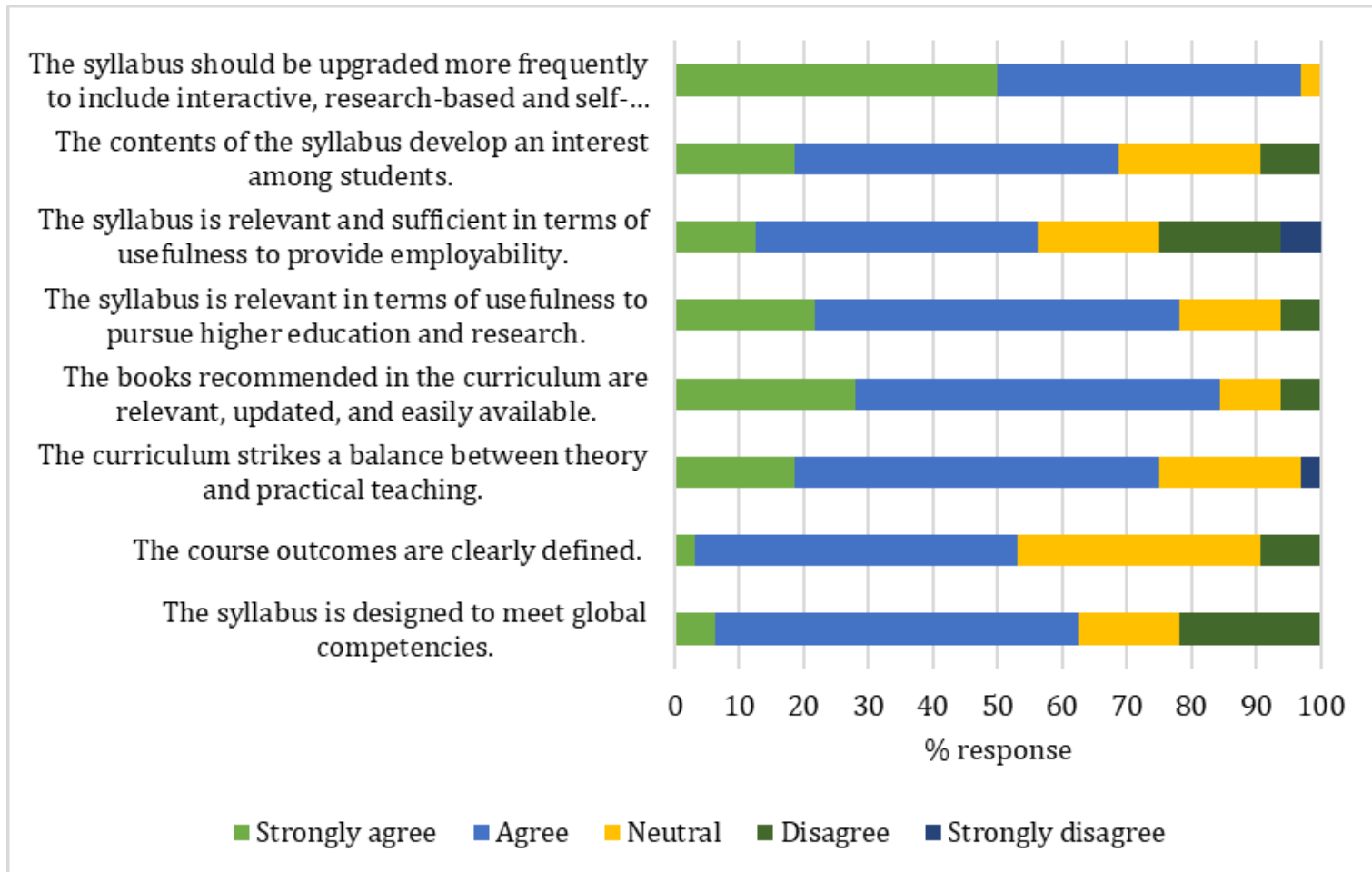
Feedback on curriculum by students

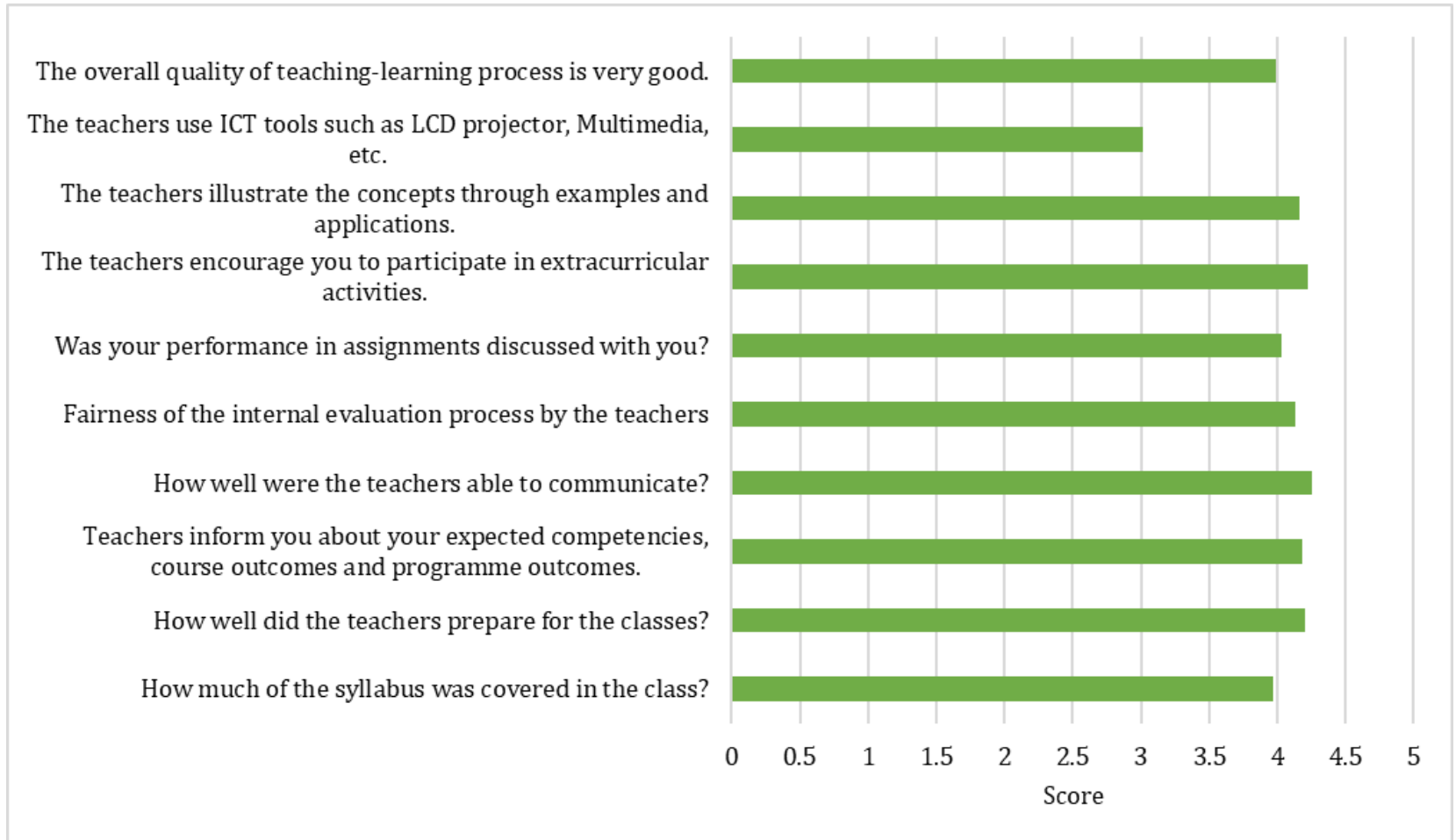

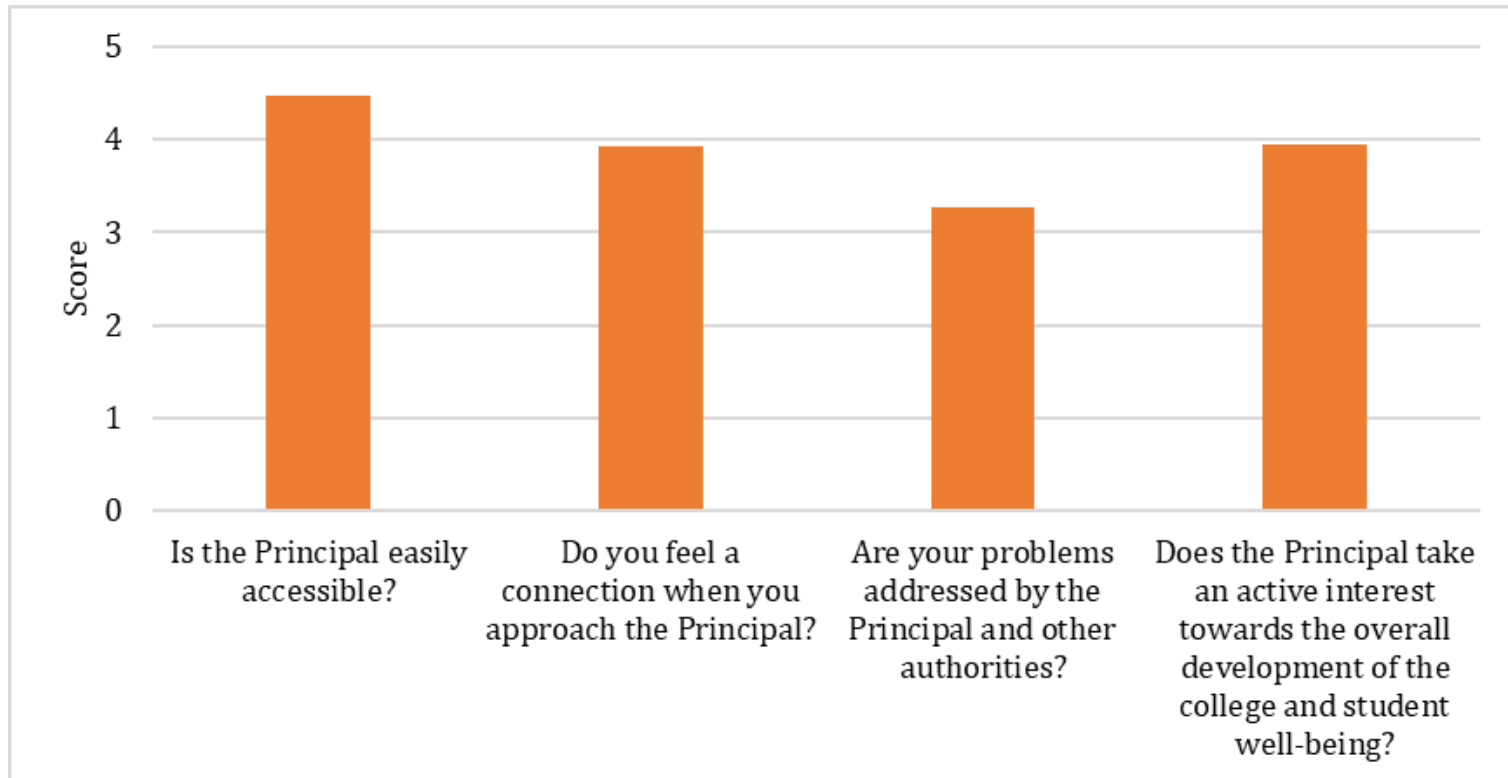

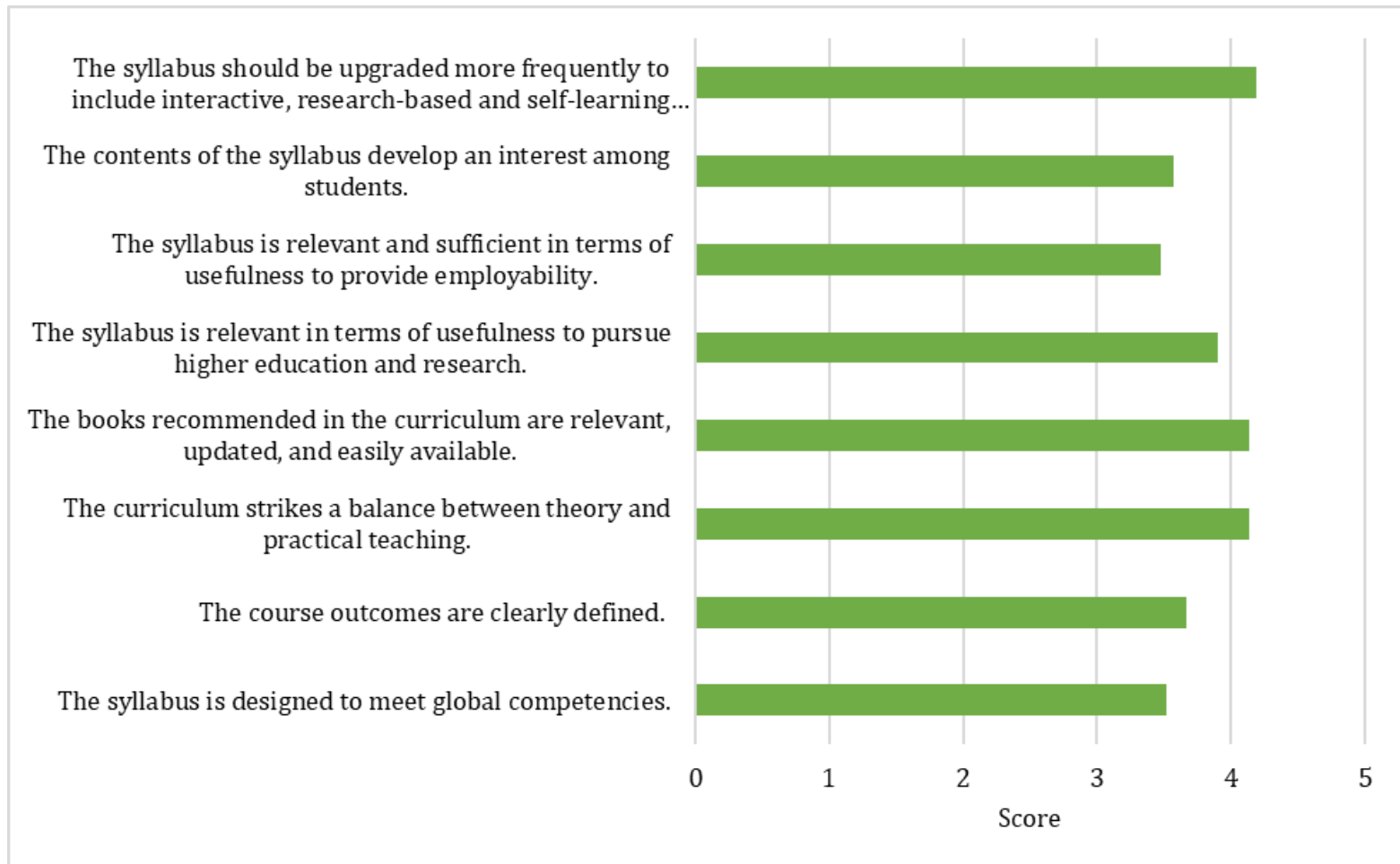

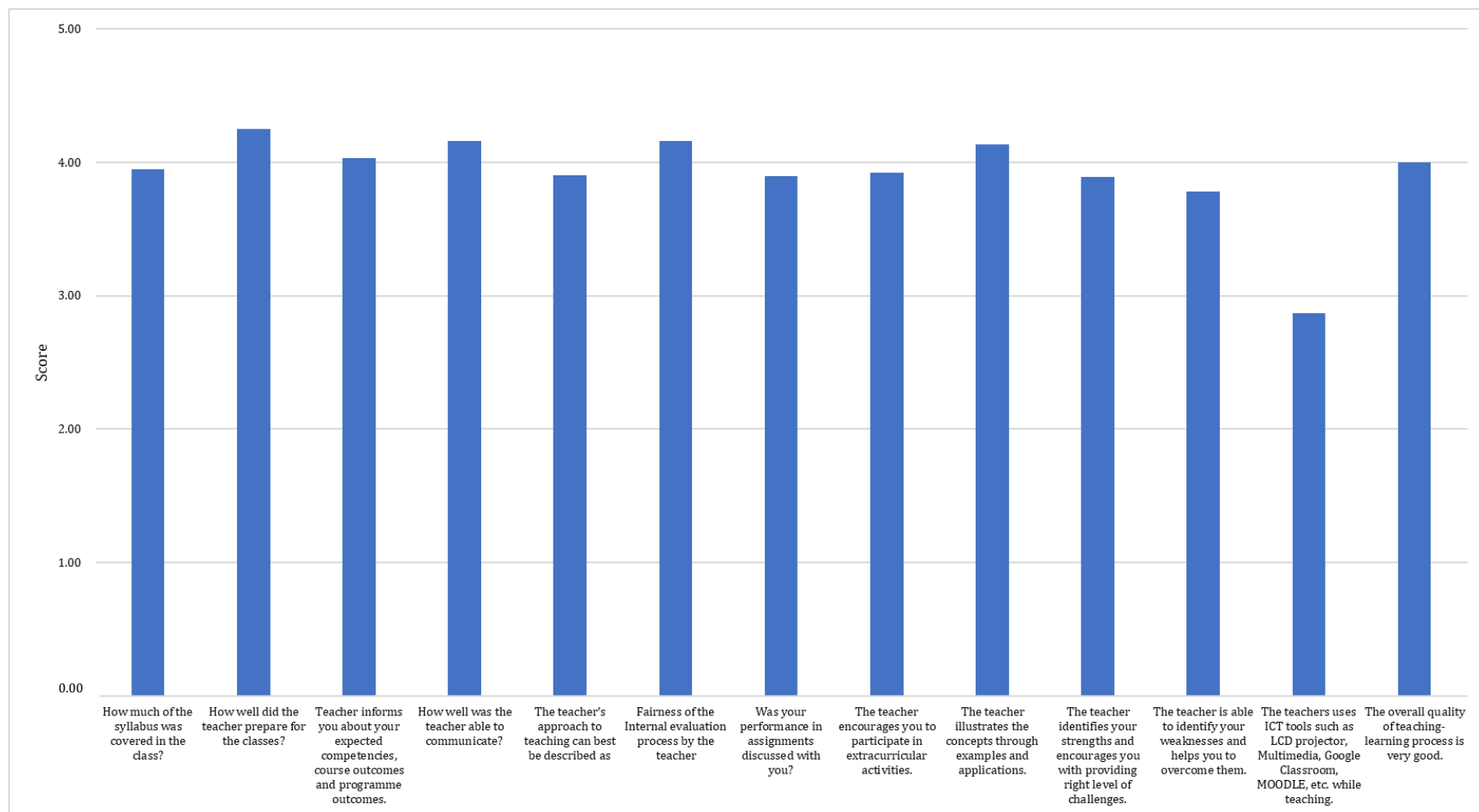

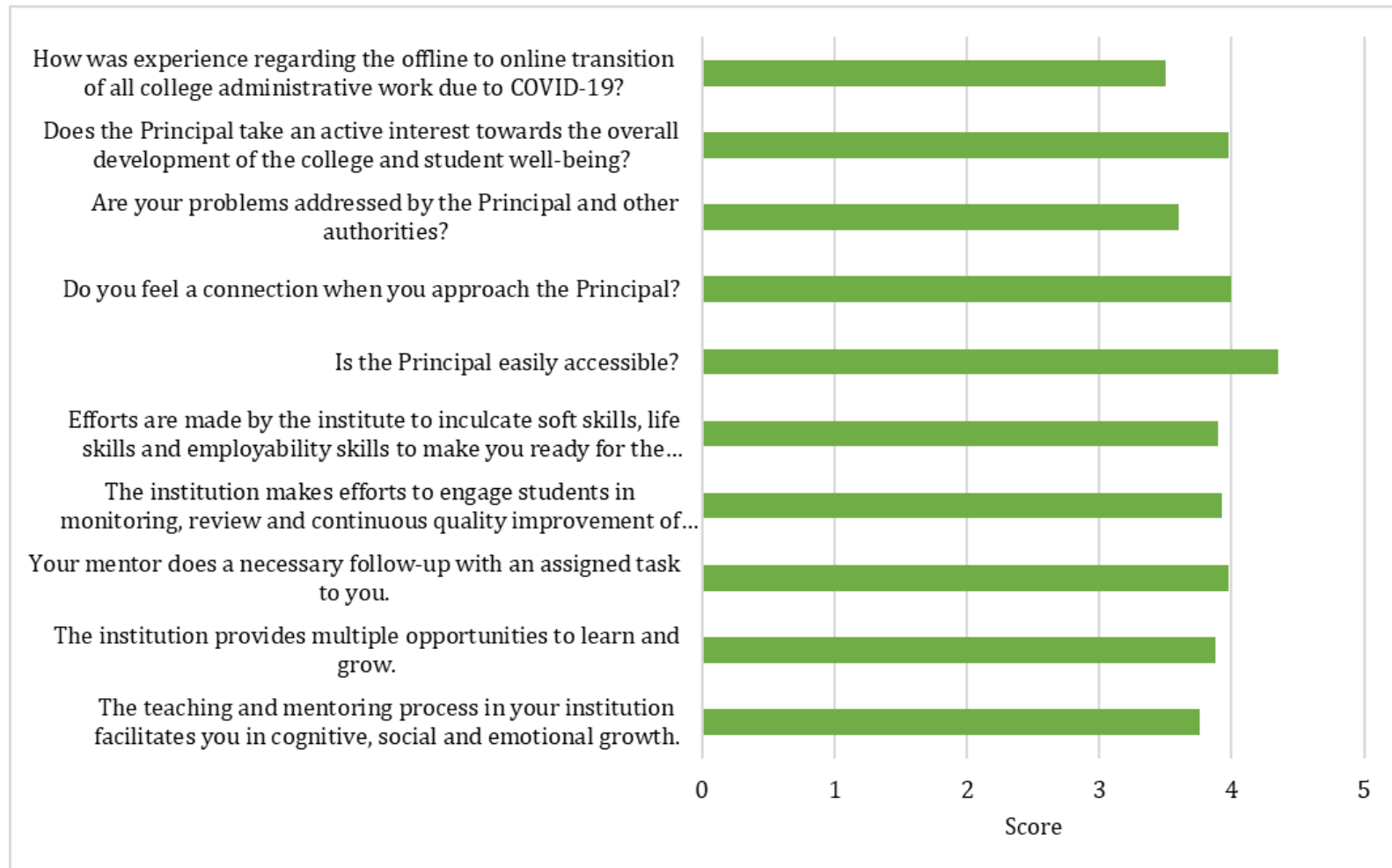


Feedback on teaching-learning by students

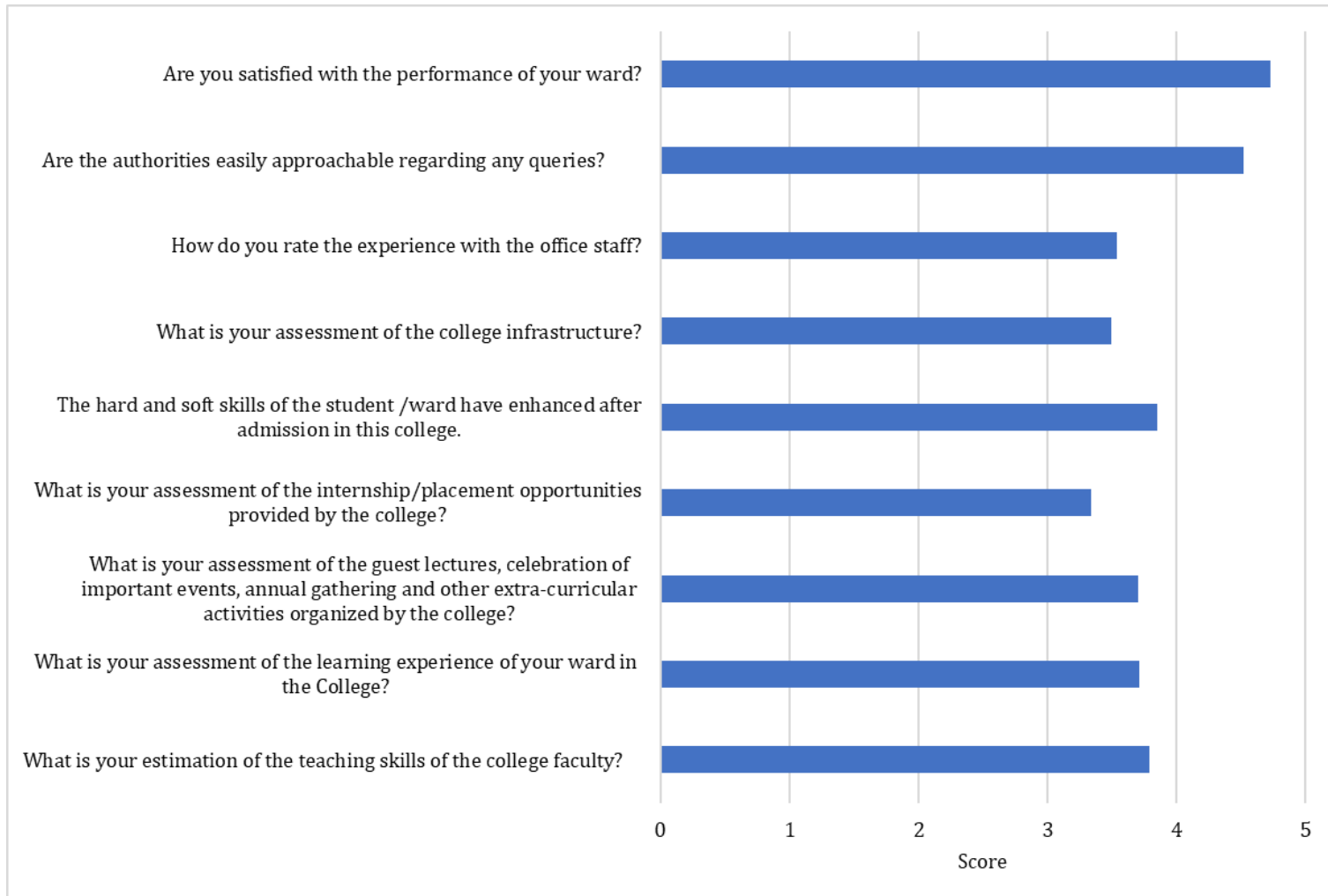

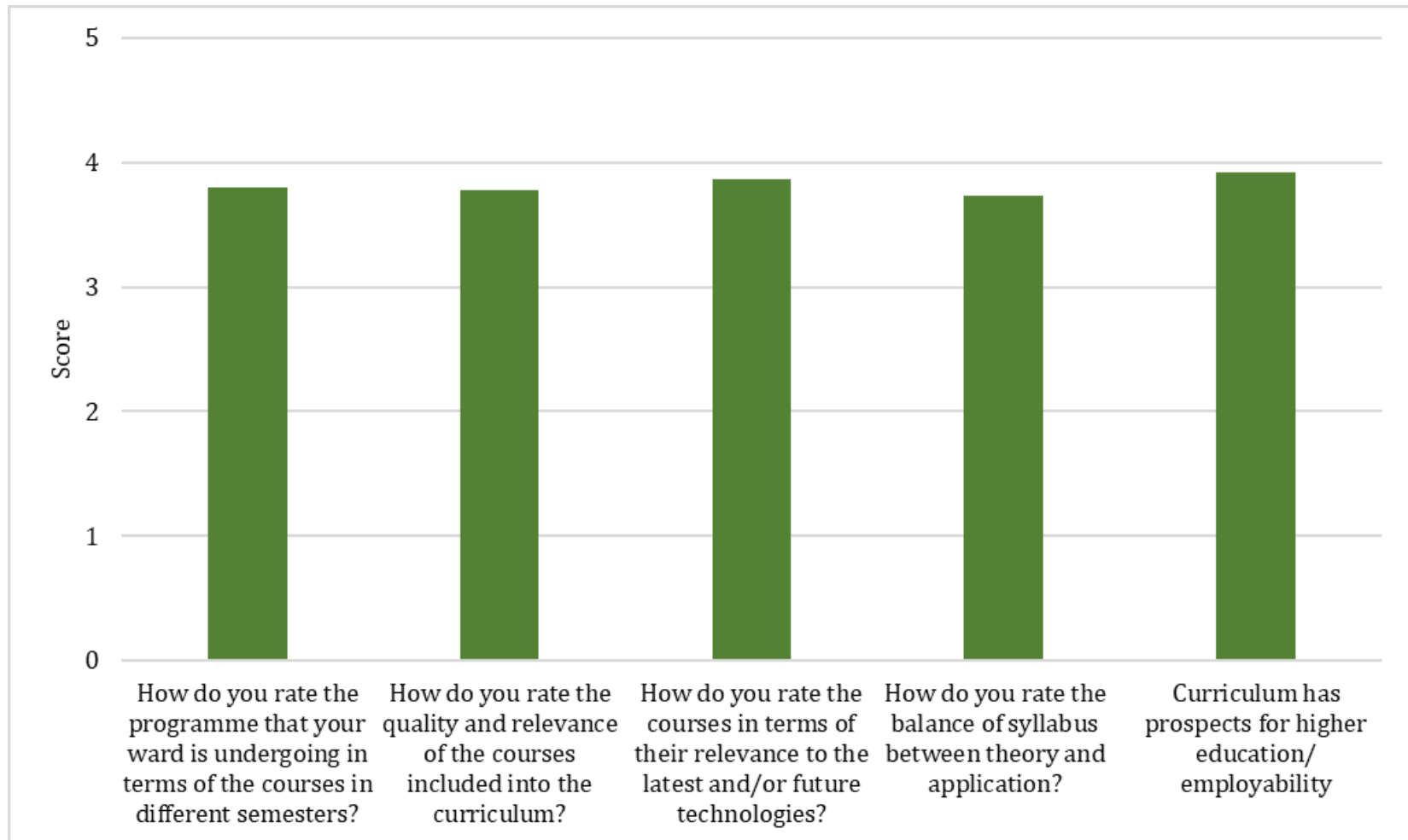

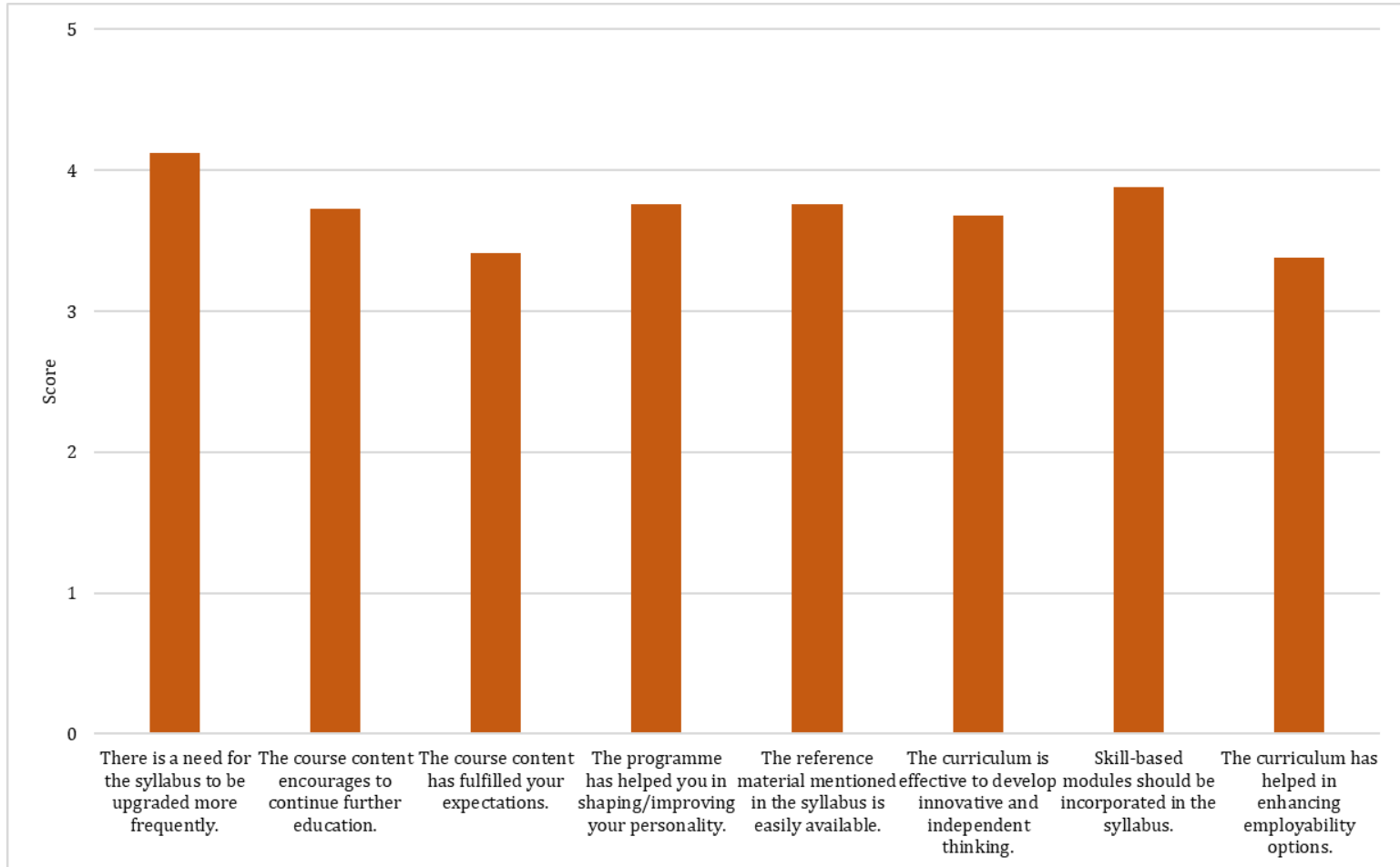

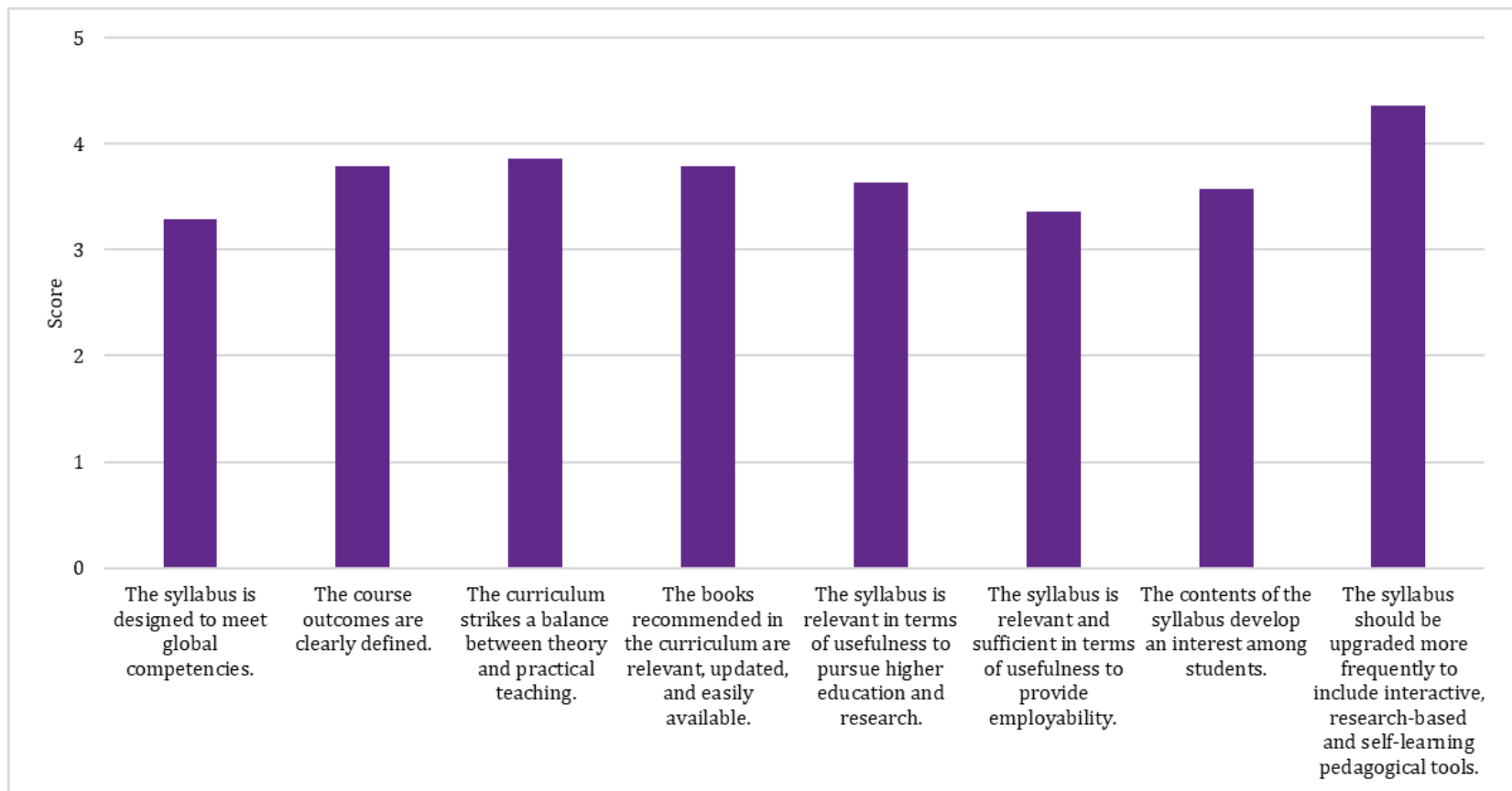

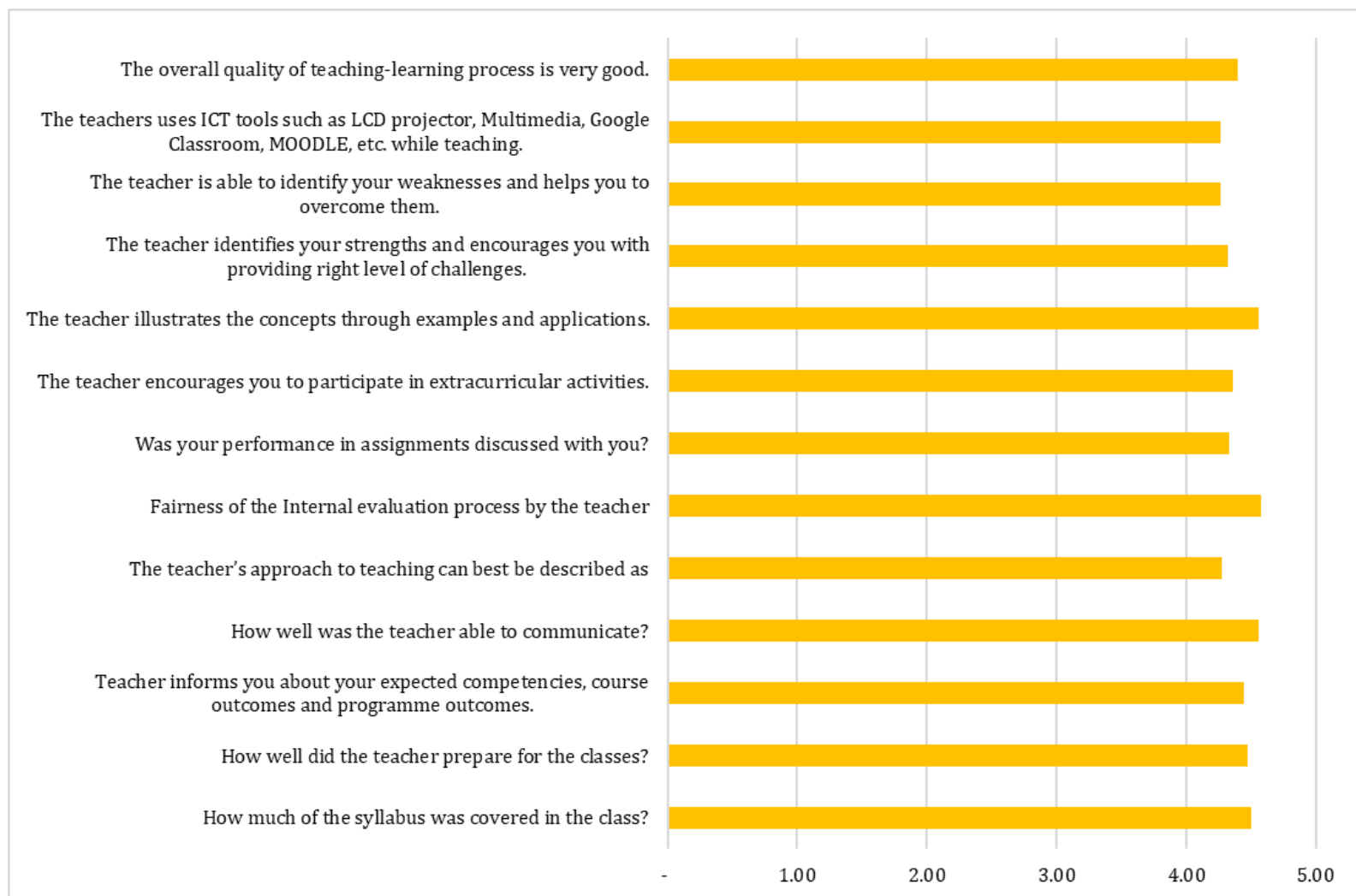

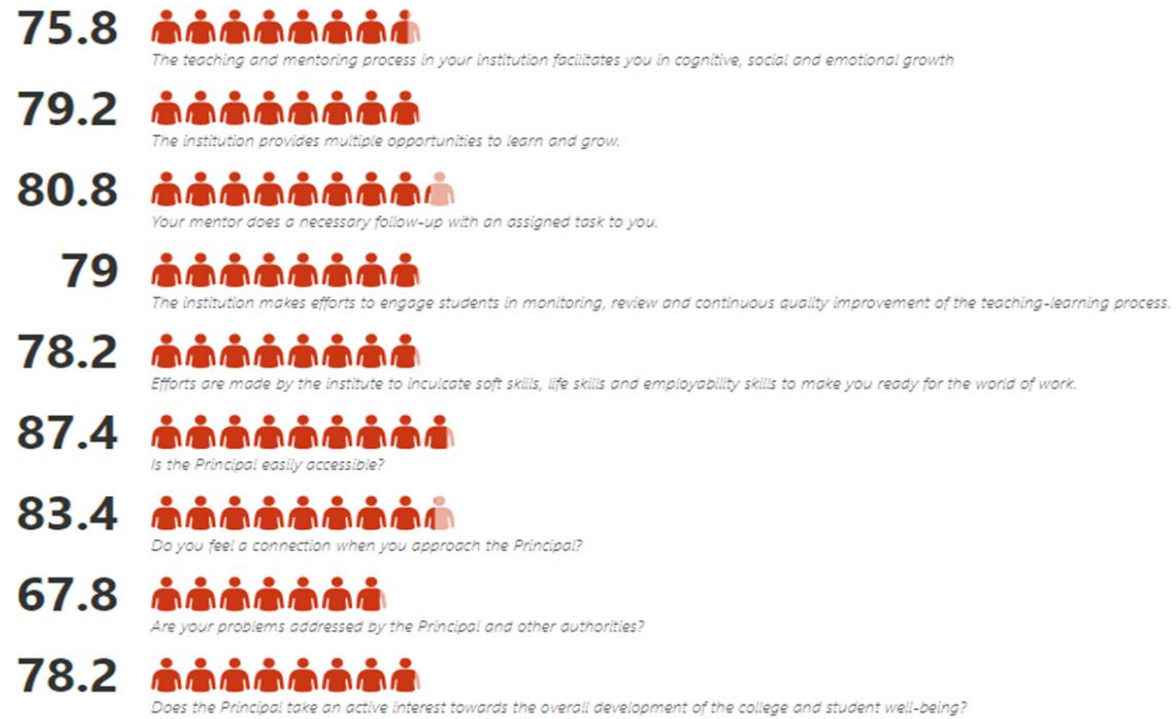
