The feedback was collected and analysed from various stakeholders and the action taken on it is given below:

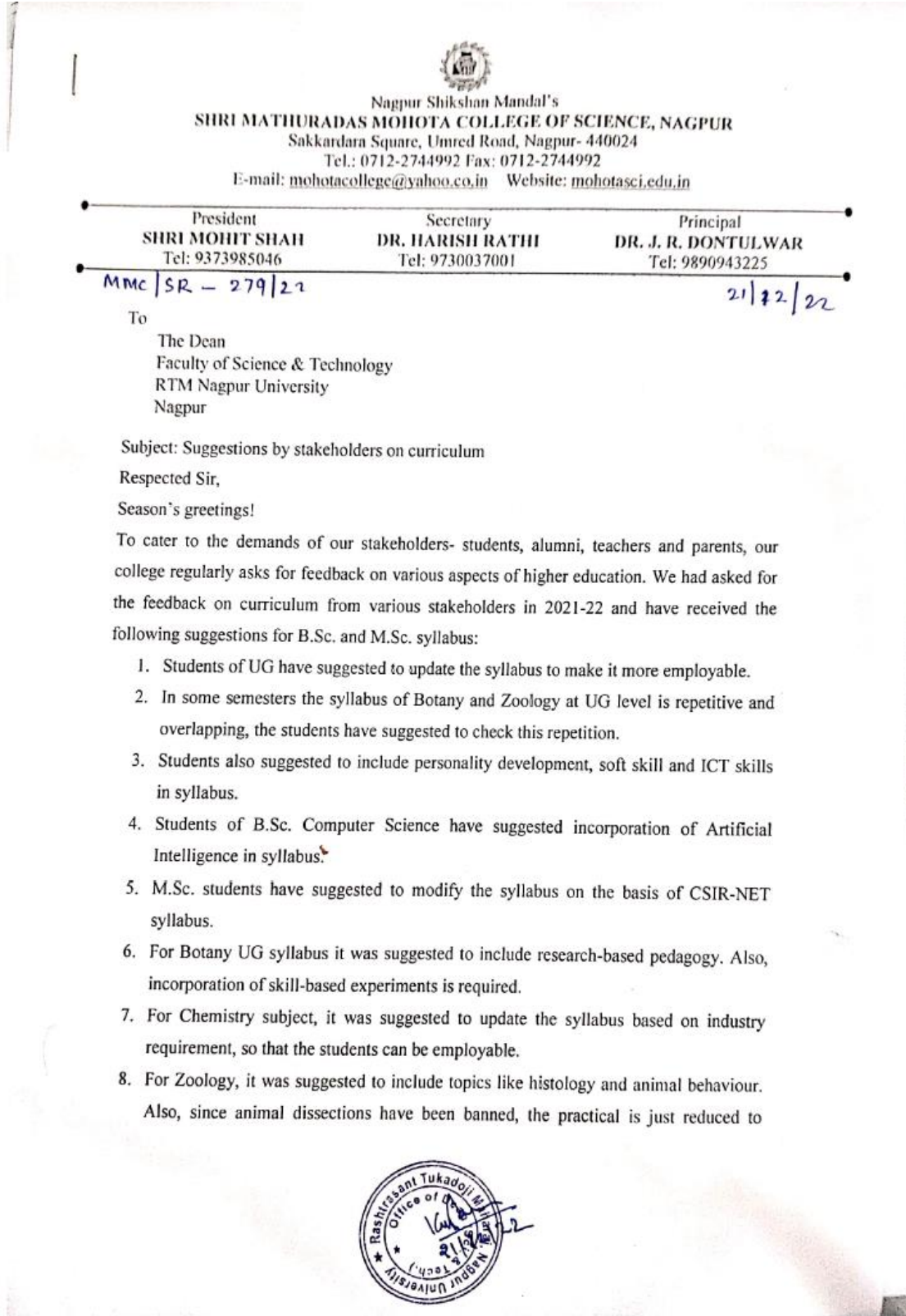
- The feedback received from students and staff members on curriculum will be communicated to the relevant authorities of the university.
