PCR is a machine called thermal cycle essential tool in any modern Molecular Biology laboratory use to amplify fragments of DNA required in various experiments to understand phylogenetic of organisms, cloning technology in recombination of DNA molecules, forensic science, secondary metabolites production, drug designing, protein engineering etc.

Looking into the importance of use PCR in contemporary sciences and to give first hand training to practice on purchased new PCR in the Department of Botany of the college workshops was organized to train students and the teachers.


- what is IPR?






In this 1 hour lecture she explained the following issues:


